- LEAGUE SHEETS** – Dated as of the first week of each window (Nov & Jan) – not required if BLS software is used. LEAGUE SHEETS dated as of Jan. 1, 2012 are required for District Finals average verification
- ADDRESSES & PHONE NUMBERS** of all District Final qualifiers
- USBC MEMBERSHIP LISTING** showing all current certified bowlers and USBC membership numbers for 2011-12
- ENTRY FEES** – **NO CASH, PERSONAL CHECKS or ON-SITE PAYMENTS ALLOWED.** Only one cashier's check, money order or bowling center check per window accepted, **payable to: CUSBC.**

AVERAGES (a) Highest certified league average (minimum of 15 games) dated as of January 1, 2012. If none, (b) Highest certified average as of the tournament date (minimum of 15 games). If none, (c) Highest previous season certified average (min. of 21 games). If none of the above, (d) Bowl scratch (210) – No league sheet necessary.

Rule 319c will apply. The average of a bowler may be adjusted upward before participation in any event. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded. It is the bowler's responsibility to provide average verification for the handicap division. Any falsification of the highest known average will result in immediate disqualification. All standing sheets must be received and verified by the end of the last squad of the District Finals. Failure to provide this information will result in the bowler receiving "210" for their average. Sole certified "sport" averages will be adjusted.

- District Directors will process and verify all paperwork. Centers will be scheduled on a first come, first serve basis.
- Final level of competition for the 11-under division earning scholarships based on a ratio of **at least 1:8 per division.**
- The 12-up divisions are competing for scholarships and advancement to the State Finals based on a ratio of **at least 1:5 per division. Finalists will be notified** by their Coach or District Director before the RSVP window begins. Qualifiers will also be posted at www.CalUSBC.com.

SQUAD TIMES Sat, May 7 at 9am & 2pm or Sun, May 8 at 8:30am**ENTRY FEE** NO BOWLING FEE; Bowlers provide their own hotel/transportation arrangements. One-time entry.**FORMAT** One (6) game qualifying block moving pairs after each game. After all squads are completed, the overall top four bowlers in each division (16 bowlers total) will qualify for the Stepladder Roll-Offs*. *Determines berths & scholarship placement.

AVERAGES (a) Highest certified league average (min. of 15 games) dated as of APRIL 15, 2012. If none, (b) Highest certified current league average (min. of 15 games) closest to competition date. If none, (c) Bowl scratch (210) – No league sheet necessary.

Rule 319c will apply. The average of a bowler may be adjusted upward before participation in any event. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded. It is the bowler's responsibility to provide average verification for the handicap divisions. Any falsification of the highest known average will result in immediate and final disqualification. Standing sheets for average verification are due by Sunday, May 6 at noon. Failure to provide this information will result in the bowler receiving "210" for their average. Sole certified "sport" averages will be adjusted.

- **State Qualifiers MUST RSVP their squad choice online at www.CalUSBC.com in order to participate.** Instructions are printed on the District Finals recap and on the back of this sheet. **DO NOT CALL FOUNTAIN BOWL WITH ANY QUESTIONS.**
- All 12-up divisions are competing for scholarships based on ratio of 1:8. The final top two finishers (2 boys/2 girls) in the 12-up Handicap Divisions will earn a FREE entry into the California State Youth Championships (**Summer 2012**) in Orange County.
- The final top two finishers (2 boys/2 girls) in the 12-up Scratch Division will earn a FREE entry plus a travel stipend into the North Pointe Jr. Gold Championships (**July 14-20, 2012**) in Indianapolis, IN. (See State Rules).
