**2010 PRINCE/PRINCESS SINGLES TOURNAMENT**

(Averages 175 and under)

**Tournament Rules**

(Please read carefully)

1. An entrant must be a current adult member in good standing of their local association, the California USBC Association and the USBC.
2. Average must be 175 or under.
3. Tournament will consist of a six (6) game Singles Event (2 three game block), changing lanes each block.
4. Tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis of 100% of 200.
5. Bowlers may enter only once.
6. **Entering average:**
  - a. April 15, 2010 highest USBC certified league average (21 or more games)
  - b. Summer 2010 highest USBC certified league average (21 or more games)
  - c. April 15, 2009 highest USBC certified league average (21 or more games)
  - d. All others excluded
7. It will be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average whether originally submitted by the bowler or others. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.
8. ***SUBMIT AN AVERAGE VERIFICATION FROM THE LOCAL USBC ASSOCIATION OFFICE WITH THE ENTRY.***
9. A replacement will be allowed. Rule 6 (averages) will apply for replacement average.
10. USBC rules 319a2 (10 pin increase in average), 319d (reporting of prize winnings) and 319e (15 pin increase in accumulated tournament average) will be waived.
11. Entry fee breakdown will be: Prize Fund \$18.00, Lineage \$16.50, Expense \$5.50 for a total of \$40.00. Entries must be accompanied by a check made payable to CUSBC. Write "Prince or Princess Tournament" in memo. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or money order on-site plus a \$25 penalty fee.
12. All prize money will be returned 100%. Prize ratio at least one prize for each six (6) entries. All prize money will be based on total pins plus handicap.
13. Check in payment of prize money won will be mailed within thirty (30) days after the close of the tournament except when the USBC has authorized delay in payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest, which affects position standings.
14. This tournament is certified by USBC.
15. **Tournament dates:** October 22-24, 2010. **Entries will close:** September 25, 2010.
16. Bowlers will check in one hour prior to schedule time and must present USBC membership for 2010-11.
17. A bowler arriving late will receive zeros for all frames missed and may bowl with their score beginning in the frame in progress.
18. The tournament officials shall have full power to act on any disputes or complaints.
19. Any appeal or protest shall be made in writing to the Board of Directors of the California USBC Association or the USBC before prize payments are made. This appeal or protest shall state briefly the grounds for appeal or protest and the action of the California USBC Association Board of Directors shall be final unless an appeal is filed with the USBC.
20. Fees are refundable ONLY when the Tournament Director is notified, in writing, within 15 days of the schedule notice mailing, that the date and time assigned are not acceptable, or in the case of an emergency, at the discretion of Tournament Director.
