CALIFORNIA USBC ASSOCIATION (CUSBC)
PRINCE & PRINCESS SINGLES TOURNAMENT RULES (175 Averages or Less)

1. This tournament is open to all current USBC adult members in good standing certified by California Associations. Participants **MUST** also have an established California USBC association average per Rule #5. **NO CARDS SOLD ON SITE.**
2. Entrants must hold a USBC certified average of 175 or less.
3. This tournament will consist of a six (6) game Singles Event (two 3 game blocks) moving pairs after game three.
4. The tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis – 100% of 200.
5. Entrants may enter only once.

The entering average shall be determined by the following priorities from an established California league:

- a. Highest certified league average (minimum of 21 games) dated as of **APRIL 15, 2012**. If none,
- b. Highest certified league average (minimum of 21 games) dated as of **APRIL 15, 2011**. If none,
- c. Highest certified league-ending **SUMMER 2011** average (minimum of 21 games). If none,
- d. All others excluded

SUBMIT AN AVERAGE VERIFICATION FROM THE LOCAL USBC ASSOCIATION OFFICE WITH THE ENTRY.

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages. Any falsification of the highest known average will result in immediate and final disqualification. If a certified "sport" league average is the bowler's only average, then it will be adjusted per the chart in the USBC Rulebook to determine the correct entering average. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winning will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.

6. USBC rules 319a2 (10 pin increase in average), 319d (reporting of prize winnings) and 319e (15 pin increase in accumulated tournament average) will be waived.
7. Replacements for original entrants may be made providing the replacement meets eligibility and average requirements per Rule 5. A replacement must bowl under their own name at the time the event is scheduled.
8. **Tournament dates:** October 20-21, 2012. **Closing date:** September 25, 2012.
9. **Entry fee breakdown:** Lineage: \$19.50; Prize Fund: \$15.00; Expenses: \$5.50; Total \$40.00. Checks or money orders will be accepted made payable to CUSBC. Write "Prince or Princess Tournament" in memo. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or money order on-site plus a \$25 penalty fee.
10. All prize money will be returned 100%. Prize ratio at least one prize for each six (6) entries. All prize money will be based on total pins plus handicap. In the event of first place ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally.
11. Designated prize funds will be paid accordingly to each division within 30 days upon completion of the tournament, except when USBC nationals has authorized delay in payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest which effects position standings.
12. Bowlers must check in 45 minutes prior to scheduled squad time and must show proof of membership by showing their USBC membership card, a duplicate membership card printout from www.bowl.com or a letter of verification from the local USBC association.
13. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made-up. Bowlers not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
14. In the event a bowler cannot finish her series, zero points will be scored the remaining frames.
15. This tournament is certified by USBC.
16. The Tournament Director shall be the authority to interpret USBC and tournament rules, policies and procedures in deciding disputes. If deemed necessary, the tournament director shall consult with the board of directors of the CUSBC.
17. An appeal or protest of a decision involving eligibility or playing rules must be filed in writing with the tournament director and the USBC before tournament prizes are paid. The decision of USBC is final and binding on all involved parties. Any violation of tournament rules is cause for disqualification, loss of entry fee, forfeit of all prize monies and possible suspension from USBC membership.
